MINISTRY DESCRIPTION

MINISTRY POSITION: Director of Music

QUALIFICATIONS - the Director of Music must:

- Be a Born-again Christian who possesses and exemplifies Christ-like attitudes and characteristics.
- Exhibit the fruit of the Spirit as described in Galatians 5:22 23
- Maintain a dynamic, personal relationship with Jesus Christ through personal prayer and Bible study.
- Possess the integrity, leadership and motivational skills needed to faithfully lead and earn the respect of the members of the Music Ministry.
- Exhibit the musical expertise required to skillfully perform the obligations outlined below to the glory and honor of God.

ACCOUNTABILITIES - to faithfully perform the duties of this position, the Director of Music will:

- Oversee the entire Music Ministry of the Church.
- Supervise Musicians, Directors and other leaders in the Music Ministry.
- Coordinate the scheduling of choirs for all worship services.
- Accompany choirs for rehearsals and worship services as needed.
- Prepare for and attend rehearsals of the Church choirs for which they serve as director or primary musician.
- Plan, prepare for and conduct musician rehearsals as necessary.
- Foster an environment that promotes spiritual growth, development and maturity within the Music Ministry.
- Ensure that choir repertoires are biblically based and enhance the overall worship experience.
- Assist in planning worship services, choir rehearsals and special musical events as necessary.
- Select and teach music to the choirs for which they serve as primary musician.
- Maintain a regular time of individual practice and skill enhancement.
- Ensure proper care and maintenance of Church musical equipment.
- Conduct regular Music Committee meetings.
- Perform other related responsibilities as assigned.
