MINISTRY POSITION: Choir Director

QUALIFICATIONS - the Choir Director must:

- Be a Born-again Christian who possesses and exemplifies Christ-like attitudes and characteristics.
- Exhibit the fruit of the Spirit as described in Galatians 5:22 - 23
- Maintain a dynamic, personal relationship with Jesus Christ through personal prayer and Bible study.
- Possess the integrity, leadership and motivational skills needed to faithfully lead and earn the respect of the members of the Music Ministry.
- Exhibit a clear understanding of music conducting necessary to skillfully perform the obligations outlined below to the glory and honor of God.

ACCOUNTABILITIES - to faithfully perform the duties of this position, the Choir Director will:

- Oversee the entire ministry of the Church choir for which they serve as Choir Director.
- Conduct the choir for all services of the Church as assigned, both regular and special. (Sunday, church engagements and otherwise as assigned)
- Schedule, prepare for and conduct all rehearsals of the Church choir for which they serve as Choir Director.
- Select and teach music to the choir for which they serve as Choir Director.
- Ensure that the choir's repertoire is biblically based and enhances the worship experience.
- Encourage accountability of Musicians, Officers and other leaders of the choir for which they serve as Choir Director.
- Foster an environment which promotes spiritual growth, development and maturity within the choir.
- Assist in planning worship services and special musical events as necessary.
- Seek opportunities for personal skill enhancement.
- Attend scheduled Music Committee meetings.
- Perform other related responsibilities as assigned.
