

WISDOM FOR CHOIR DIRECTORS



- ▶ Don't be too eager to be a director. [*James 3:1*]
- ▶ Be kind, tender-hearted. Not mean spirited. [*Ephesians 4:32*]
- ▶ Pray that the fruit of the Spirit would be reflected in your directing.
[*Galatians 5:22 - 23*]
- ▶ Lead with confidence not pride or arrogance. [*Mark 1:22; Romans 12:3; Proverbs 11:2; 16:18*]
- ▶ Be a good follower.
- ▶ Exhibit humility. (Be a servant leader) [*Matthew 23:11 - 12, John 13:4 - 5*]
- ▶ Know your choir's limits - so you can lovingly/strategically stretch them.
- ▶ Know every part. (Don't guess at rehearsal)
- ▶ Come to rehearsal with a plan. [*I Corinthians 14:40*]
- ▶ Foster a spirit of teamwork. (use inclusive language like "let's try", "we need to" and "how about we" rather than "I want you to", "you better") [*Ephesians 4:3 - 6*]
- ▶ Make sure your movements and stage presence reflect Christ.
[*Philippians 4:5, I Corinthians 11:1*]
