


- 1 The musical alphabet goes from **A** to **G** and then repeats
- 2 Notice the black keys are in groups of 2 and groups of 3
- 3 Around the group of 2 black keys
 - C is the white key to the left of the group of 2 black keys
 - **D** is the white key between the group of 2 black keys
 - **E** is the white key to the right of the group of 2 black keys




- 4 Around the group of 3 black keys
 - **F** is the white key to the left of the group of 3 black keys
 - **G** is the white key between the 1st and 2nd black keys in the group of 3 black keys
 - A is the white key between the 2nd and 3rd black keys in the group of 3 black keys
 - **B** is the white key to the right of the group of 3 black keys



- 5 A sharp (#) means play the closest higher (to the right) key. A sharp is usually a black key but not always.
- 6 A flat (b) means play the closest lower (to the left) key. A flat is usually a black key but not always.
