Instead of saying this:	Try saying this:
"I disagree."	"I hear you. I just see it from a different point of view."
"You're wrong."	"I'm not sure that's totally correct."
"That's stupid!"	"Hmm. That's an interesting way to look at it."
"No offense but"	(Remove this phrase from your vocabulary. It is offensive and charged with hostility.)
"Have you gained some weight?" "Are you graying/balding?" "You look too skinny."	"It's good to see you again." (We are to edify and build up one another not insult, offend, pull down or draw negative attention to personal or physical imperfections.)
"What's wrong with you?"	"Is there something on your mind?"
"See, your problem is"	(Remove this phrase from your vocabulary. It is full of malice and bitterness.)
"I want you to"	"Would you help me"
"We need to talk!"	"When can we get together?"
"You should be more like"	(Remove this phrase from your vocabulary. God made each of us unique.)
"Are you crazy?"	"Excuse me. I'm not sure I heard that correctly."
"I know how you feel." (to someone grieving or going through a tough time.)	"I pray that God would give you grace through this season." (Feelings are personal. You can never know how someone else feels.)
"Don't worry. A lot of folks have been through that."	"I feel for you. That must be real tough." (Never belittle someone's feelings.)
"I really can't stand him/her!" "He/She gets on my last nerve!"	"I'm having trouble loving him/her. Pray for God to help me show the love of the Lord."
"Stop complaining!"	"I don't know what to say. It sounds like that really struck a nerve."
